Memories from 42 Years with RIVA Co-Founder, Jo Ann Hairston

RIVA began in the basement of Naomi's house with a Selectric typewriter and a printer that made four copies a minute. The other inhabitant of the basement was BJ, a small but vocal black cat whose idea of fun was to pick up a piece of string, clamp her mouth around it and meow with her mouth closed. It never failed to crack us up.

I can vividly remember the night before our first class as Naomi and I sat up late filling three-ring binders with the handouts and materials for the class. I wondered aloud how our college degrees had led us to this moment, but the next day began RIVA's future as a company that provided experiential training for freelance moderators. Over time the mix of students changed from freelancers to a mix of people who worked for market research companies and companies who wanted to bring moderating skills in-house. Although I never imagined that I would still be teaching 42 years later, I'm firmly convinced that it is some of the most important work of my life outside of raising my family.
